**Invitation for Expression of Interests regarding Potential Participation in Call for Tenders for Logistics Services related to Block 9 operations in Lebanon**

**(Logistics Base Services, Marine Gas Oil Supply, Vessel Support Services, and Helicopter Services)**

**I. CONTEXT**

TotalEnergies EP Block 9 is a company incorporated in France with a branch that is currently being registered in Lebanon and has its activities in Lebanon ("TOTALENERGIES"). TOTALENERGIES, together with its partners Eni Lebanon B.V. and QatarEnergy International Investments (2) LLC have entered into Exploration and Production Agreement with the Republic of Lebanon for the conduct of petroleum activities in Block 9 offshore Lebanon. TOTALENERGIES is the Operator in charge of conducting the petroleum activities.

TOTALENERGIES is providing the opportunity for Lebanese companies to express their interest to participate in the screening exercise, as described below. The companies who pass the screening exercise will be able to participate in Call for Tender(s) for the performance of logistics services and provision of goods in relation to the petroleum activities.

**II. WHO CAN EXPRESS INTEREST AND HOW?**

If your company is interested in participating in one or more of the Call for Tender(s) listed in Section V below (i.e. you are a "Potential Tenderer"), you must notify TOTALENERGIES of your interest by sending an Expression of Interest ("EOI") **no later than 20 February 2023** to the following e-mail address:

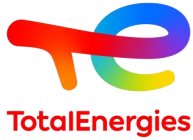
The Potential Tenderer must clearly indicate in its EOI the reference number and name of the Call for Tender that it wishes to participate in.

The Potential Tenderer will then receive by e-mail a Screening Questionnaire ("Questionnaire"). The Potential Tenderer must complete, sign and stamp the Questionnaire and send it back to the following e-mail address: [ep.liban-cpb9@totalenergies.com](mailto:ep.liban-cpb9@totalenergies.com), **no later than 14 calendar days** from the date on which the Questionnaire was originally sent to such Potential Tenderer by TOTALENERGIES.

1. Must be a Lebanese company that is majority-owned or controlled by Lebanese nationals; and
2. Must have the capability to properly perform the services described in the relevant Call for Tender. This capability must be demonstrated through experience, quality, timely performance, compliance and other criteria as described in the Questionnaire. Accordingly, the Potential Tenderer must be able to perform by itself the major part of the required services.

### III. PURPOSE OF SCREENING EXERCISE

The purpose of this screening exercise is to allow TOTALENERGIES to assess whether the Potential Tenderer fulfils, to TOTALENERGIES standards, the preliminary requirements for the provision of the required services, products or goods.

The screening exercise is a pass or fail test. The Potential Tenderers who pass the screening exercise, will be on the bidders list and will be invited in due time to participate in the relevant Call for Tender(s). Therefore, Potential Tenderers are requested to strictly comply with the Questionnaire instructions so they can be assessed by TOTALENERGIES.

### IV. NATURE OF THIS DOCUMENT

This document, including the screening exercise is not an invitation to participate in a Call for Tender and does not create any commitment or obligation on the part of TOTALENERGIES towards any of the Potential Tenderers. This document, including the screening exercise does not constitute an offer to enter into a contract. This document provides the opportunity for Potential Tenderers to express their interest in participating in future Call for Tenders if they successfully pass the screening exercise.

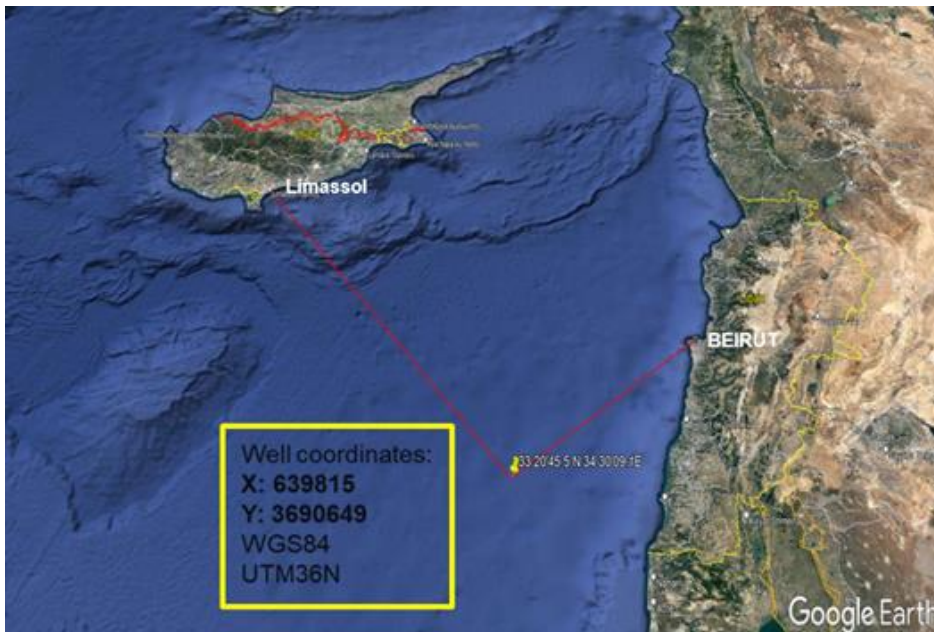
